

## Fall Inclusion Week: For Youth Educators & Students

**Overview:** Unified Champion Schools across the U.S. are invited to participate in the SONA UCS Fall Inclusion Week! **The Fall Inclusion Week** is a series of inclusive youth leadership activities consisting of different **missions, challenges and themed activities** from **October 19-22, 2021**. Teams will use the app, GooseChase, to log their activities and earn points to compete and win prizes!

**Who:** Intended for **middle level, high school, and college aged leaders**. There is one team per school made up of Unified teammates and Unified club members. Each team will **nominate Unified Co-Captains** to be the leaders throughout this event.

**GooseChase:** The GooseChase app offers users the description and criteria for each mission. This is the platform Unified Co-captains will submit their completed missions in return for points. **Role of Educators:** Educators are responsible for **offering support** to their Unified team or club (i.e., with nominating Co-Captains, assisting with missions, coordinating with State Program if school wins, etc.)

**Unified Co-Captains:** Each participating team will nominate a Unified pair (one individual with ID and one without) to be Co-captains. **Their responsibilities include...**

- Coordinating with their State Program on how to receive prizes, if team places
